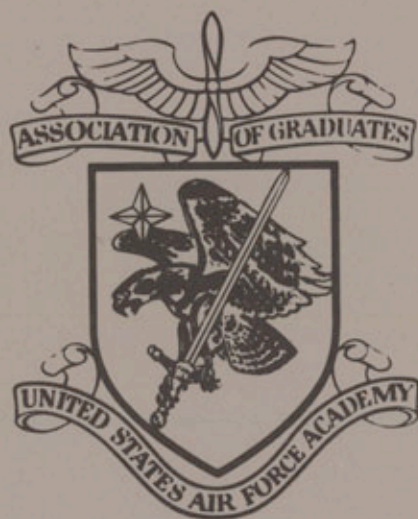

1985 JABARA AWARD FOR AIRMANSHIP

Lieutenant General Winfield W. Scott, Jr., Superintendent of the U.S. Air Force Academy, has named Colonel James N. Allburn, Class of 1963, as the winner of the 1985 Colonel James Jabara Award for Airmanship. Colonel Allburn earned the award for his leadership efforts as program manager of the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) X-29 Advanced Technology Demonstrator aircraft.

The X-29, with its forward swept-wing design, is the first manned X-series aircraft to be developed and flight tested in over a decade. Colonel Allburn's superior managerial and technical leadership led to the first flight of the X-29, providing the important design and development lessons that will be applied to our nation's future fighter aircraft. He encouraged both the services and the bidding contractors to include the widest range of new technologies into the X-29, including its distinctive forward-swept wing, its canard and flap control surfaces, digital flight control system, and its advanced composite wing structure.

Colonel Allburn worked incessantly to get many government organizations involved in the program: the Air Force providing its Advanced Development Program Office and procurement activity, the National Aeronautics and Space Administration providing flight test support and wind tunnel testing, and the Navy providing analyses of the flight control system. The high-risk, high-payoff X-29 program would not have happened without Colonel Allburn's leadership. He is the DARPA nominee.

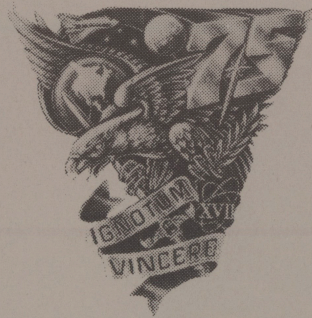
