HOMECOMING EVENTS

FRIDAY:

Golf Tournament: Grads, wives, guests — come one, come all to relive those magic days on the Academy's Blue Course. Four-person Texas Scramble (rules provided prior to tee off) and prizes! Club rental restricted to 30 available sets. Participants will miss other morning activities and lunch with cadets.

Homecoming Briefings: Get the latest on Academy programs through briefings by representatives of the superintendent, commandant, dean, director of athletics, and registrar in Arnold Hall theater.

Lunch at Mitchell Hall: Join the cadets for one of Mitch's famous lunches. *Graduates only — limited seating available.* Return your reservation form early to insure you get a seat. (Spouses and others may eat at Arnold Hall.)

Open House: Take your family on a tour of the cadet area. The chapel and dormitories will be open, so drop by your old squadron and reminisce. Check out the waterless Air Gardens, the casual firstclass rooms, the new improved "CQ Shack," and the newly-renovated rooms in Vandenberg Hall.

Afternoon Activities: Attend those classes you slept through when you were a cadet. Talk to the modern-day cadets and count how many times they put "sir" into a sentence.

All-Class Party: Join grads and guests from all classes for cocktails and hors d'oeuvres at the Academy Officers' Club.

SATURDAY:

Wake Up! Start the day with refreshments at Arnold Hall; a chance to greet late arrivals and tell tall tales.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION:

Send the completed registration form and your check to the Association of Graduates. Remember that this payment must include the registration fee as well as charges for all homecoming events (nonclass) not included in the registration fee.

The registration fee is \$28 for each AOG member and each AOG-member guest. For nonmembers and their guests the fee is \$30 a person. The registration fee includes the All-Class party, the Saturday morning coffee, the pre-game tailgate party, hors d'oeuvres at the Jabara cocktail hour, the Jabara banquet and the Homecoming Ball.

Registration Packets, Tickets, and Name Tags:

For the *Class of 1965*, may be picked up at the Hilton Inn on Thursday from 1600 to 1900.

For the *Class of 1975*, may be picked up at the Sheraton Inn on Thursday from 1600 to 1900.

Those who have not picked up their registration packet on Thursday may do so Friday at the registration desk in the lobby of Arnold Hall from 0800 to 1530. Registration packets *will not* be mailed to you. Registration packets may also be picked up from 0800 to 1130 in Arnold Hall on Saturday morning. Football tickets not picked up at registration will be given to the main ticket office near the flagpole at Falcon Stadium where they may be picked up on Saturday.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Class of '65: Headquarters is the Hilton Inn, located about 10 miles south of the Academy at Exit 146 just off I-25. Reservations can be made by writing the Hilton Inn, 505 Popes Bluff Trail, Colorado Springs, Colo. 80907, or by calling (303) 598-7656. The charges are \$46 a night for a single and \$57 for a double. The deposit is refundable with no penalty until 1800 of scheduled arrival date. Be sure to tell them that you are with the Class of '65 to get these special rates. Reservations should be made as soon as possible. Unbooked rooms will be released two weeks prior to Homecoming.

Class of '75: Headquarters is the Sheraton Inn, located at I-25 and North Academy. Reservations can be made by writing the Sheraton at 8110 N. Academy, Colorado Springs, Colo. 80919, or by calling (303) 598-5770. The charges are \$54 a night, single or double. The deposit is refundable with no penalty if you cancel not later than 48 hours in advance. Be sure to tell them that you

are with the Class of '75 to get these special rates. Reservations should be made not later than 20 August to ensure availability.

For both classes, one night's deposit or a major credit card number is required to guarantee reservations.

For those people not from the reunion classes, a limited number of rooms are available at the Drury Inn, 8155 North Academy, Colorado Springs, Colo. 80919, (303) 598-2500. When making reservations, identify yourself as being with the Academy Homecoming to get the special rates. First come, first served.

RENTAL CARS:

Rental car arrangements will be left up to the individual. Among the many agencies offering special weekend rates are: Thrifty Rent-A-Car, (800) 367-2277 or Budget Rent-A-Car, (800) 527-0700. Specify where you would like to pick up and drop off the car (Denver/Colorado Springs). A minimum two-day rental is required and both of these companies allow unlimited mileage. Weekend rates in both cases, include prices varying between \$16.00 to \$22.95 plus tax per day, depending on car size desired/available. **CONFIRM YOUR RATE IN ADVANCE.**

CANCELLATIONS:

To ensure a refund for registration fees, cancellations must be received by the AOG office before 1500, Monday, 16 September. Refunds will not normally be made for cancellations received after that deadline. Cancellations may be made by mail or phone: autovon 259-2067, or commercial (303) 472-2067. Cancellations for room reservations or car rental should be accomplished directly through the agency with which you made them. *Registration fee refunds will normally be made after Homecoming is over.*

DRESS:

Thursday night activities: Casual!

Friday All-Class Party: Appropriate attire for Officers' Club.

Friday night: '75: Activities by squadron — as required. '65: Dinner — coat and tie for men, cocktail dress for ladies.

Saturday night: Suit or sport coat and tie for men; street or floor-length dress for ladies.

All other activities: (Friday-Sunday): Service Dress recommended for active duty. Comparable attire for civilians.
