

SUBJECT: Cadet Second Squadron Emblem

TO: DFSLB (Mrs. Thompson)

The Cadet Second Squadron Emblem is a blue triangle upon which appears the small black planform of two Delta-shaped aircraft climbing vertically in echelon. Trailing downward from each aircraft is a red fire streak, both of which blend together symmetrically into the horizontal plane. Across the solid red bottom of the triangle is the word "Deuce". The two aircraft and the word "Deuce" symbolize the Number 2 for Second Squadron. The aircraft climbing vertically from their trailing fire streaks symbolizes the cadets' pursuit of their ultimate goal of flight or flight support within the Air Force. The Second Squadron motto is "Second to None".
