1. Reference HQ USAF (AFPMP-12) 1st Indorsement to our basic communication, subject "Organizational Emblems," dated 27 Sep 61, and in accordance with Air Force Regulation 900-3, request is submitted for approval of an emblem for the Twenty-Third Cadet Squadron, The Air Force Cadet Wing, United States Air Force Academy.

2. Description: The knight's helmet in profile is the traditional symbol of the esquire and gentleman. The wings represent flight; hence, the winged helmet represents the cadet and gentleman of the Air Force Academy. The second element in the emblem is the Wake or Ormande Knot, symbolic of strength through unity. The threads on the tassels of the cord number 23 and represent the 23rd Squadron. There are 6 threads on each of 3 tassels and 5 threads on the other tassel. The colors are red, black and silver. Red is the symbol of valor, typical of the squadron aggressiveness on the athletic field.
