Reference HQ USAF (AFFWP-12) 1st Indorsement to our basic communication, subject "Organizational Emblems," dated 27 Sep 61, and in accordance with Air Force Regulation 900-3, request is submitted for approval of an emblem for the Twenty-Fourth Cadet Squadron, The Air Force Cadet Wing, U.S. Air Force Academy.

2. Description: The design is a black and white spread eagle with yellow beak and red eye-shading, perched on a simulated bolt of lightning. Within the bolt of lightning is the word "Squadron" with the numerals "24" directly below it. In the background is the symbol of Polaris in black and white encircled by yellow atomic rings, all suspended in a blue sky above an eighth of a circle of the world. The entire emblem is contained in a triangular patch.
