

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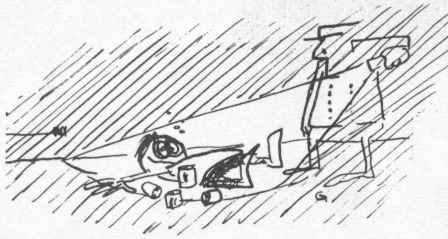

Sat 1100 - hospital

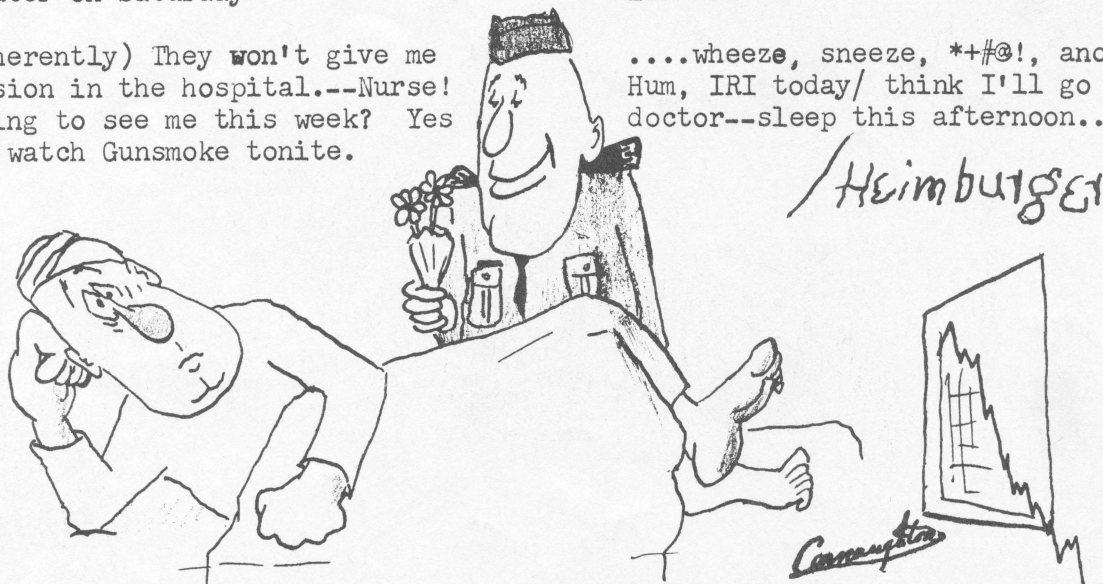
But nurse, I have a date tonite.

DP with her folks tomorrow--WOW!!!

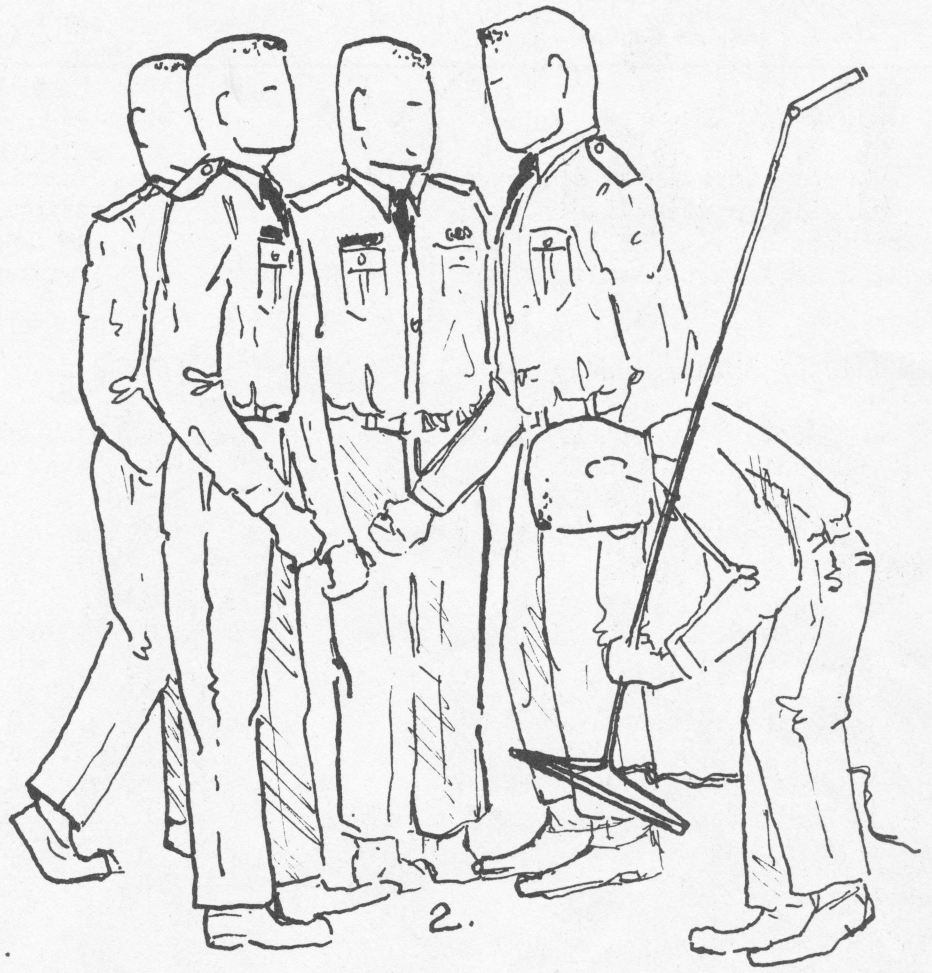
