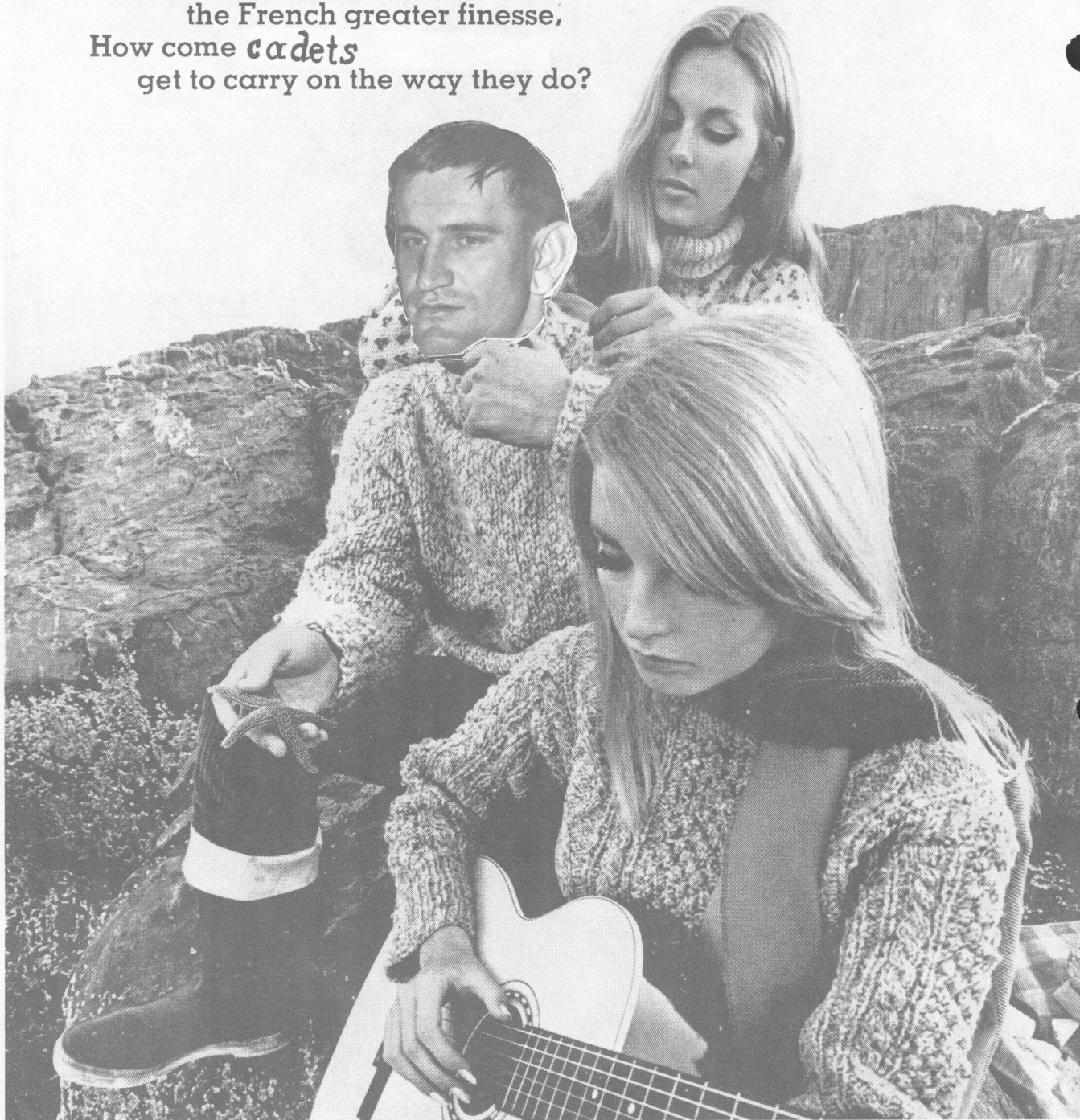
It was obvious to those of us who were there that it was more the technique than the Xavier team itself that carried them through the game toward the climax of victory.

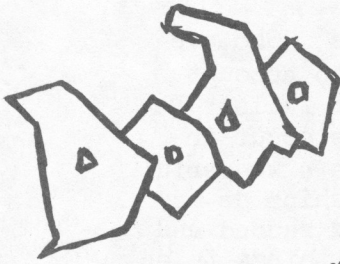

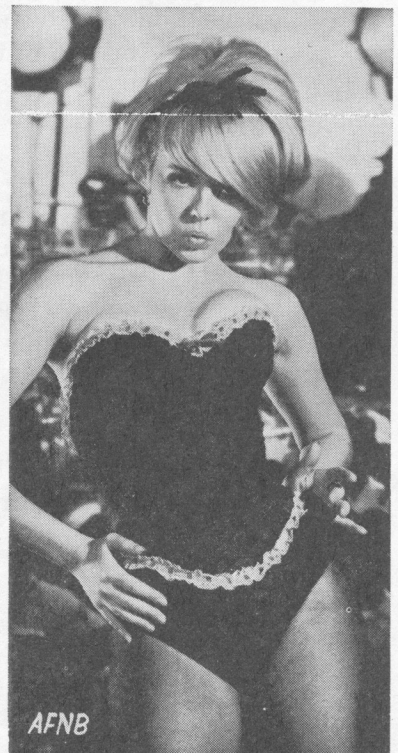

Option #3-Bribe personnel officer and take 71 days of summer leave, followed by very stiff CDB.

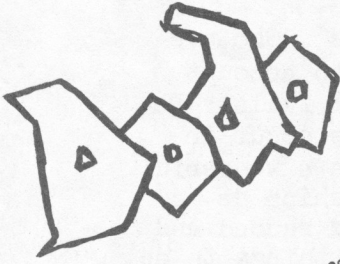
Class of '68:

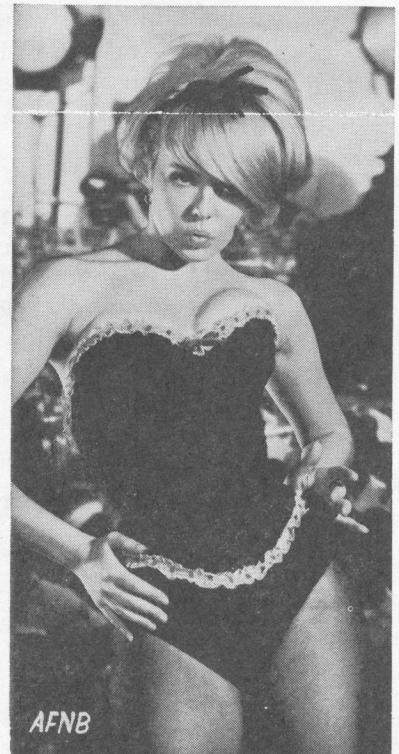

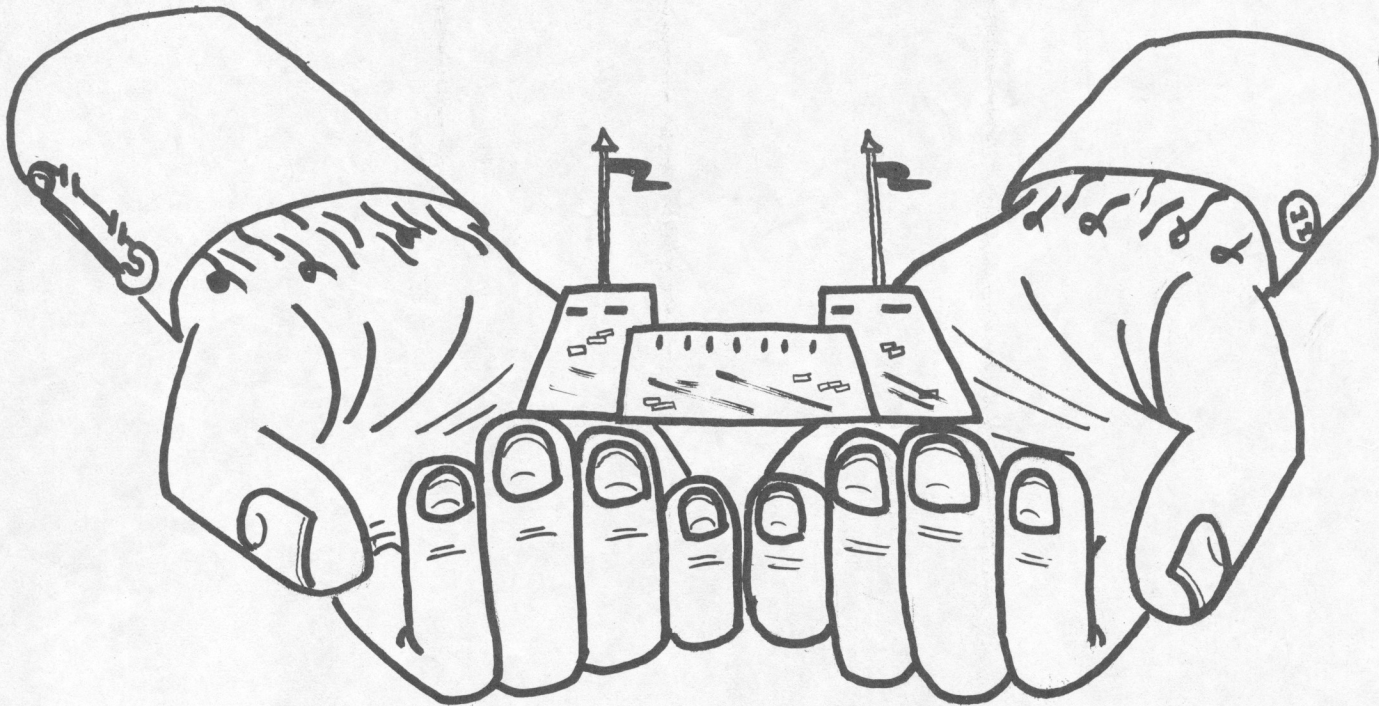
