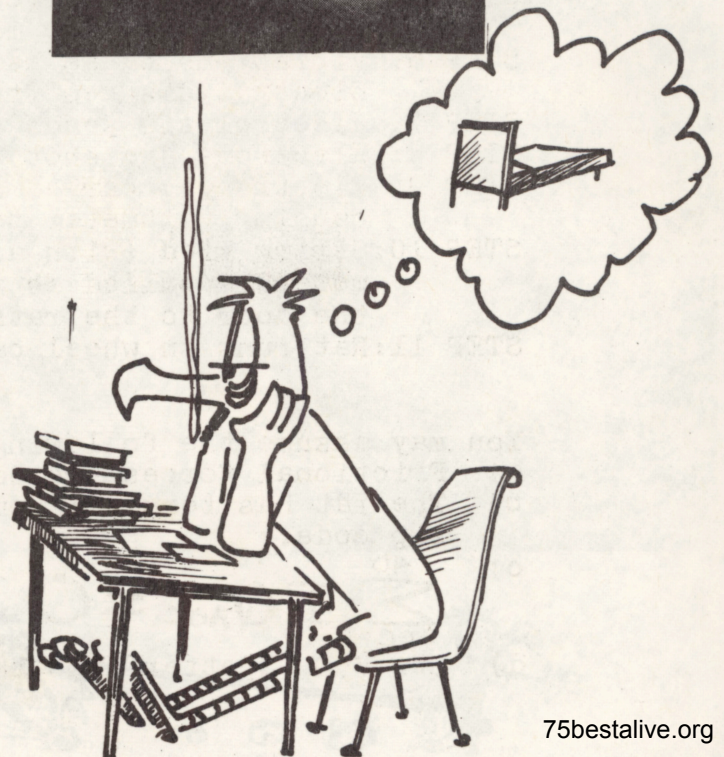

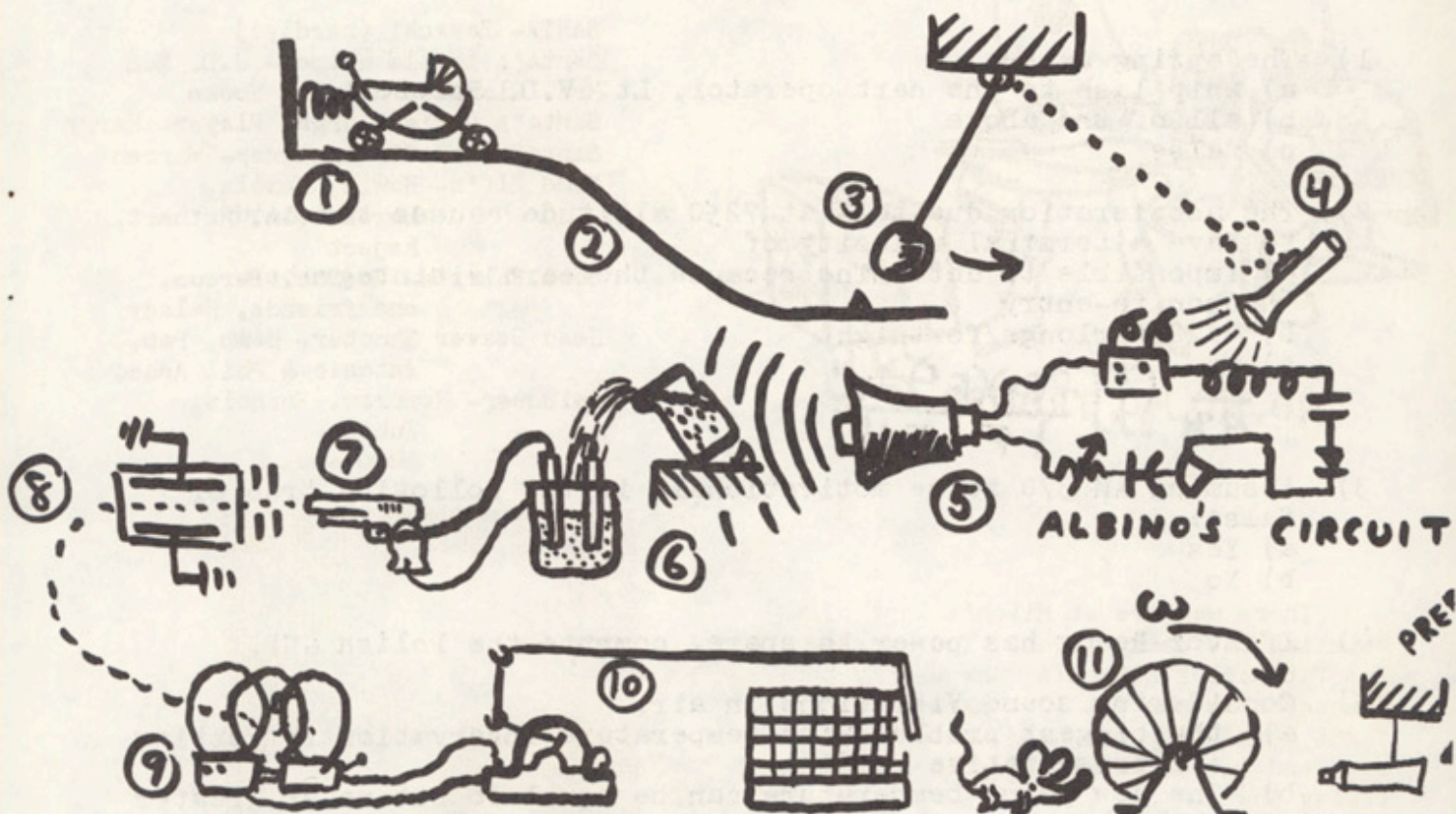

PHYSICS 220 FINAL EXAMINATION



- STEP 1: A spring of constant k produces a + acceleration on the cart
 STEP 2: The cart is further accelerated due to gravity
 STEP 3: Cart hits ball attached to string causing pendulum motion
 STEP 4: Pendulum hits flashlight switch causing light to shine on photo cell which in turn causes electricity to flow through circuit
 STEP 5: Electricity in circuit causes horn to blow sending sound vibrations in the medium of air.
 STEP 6: Vibrations cause beaker to spill Cl^- ions into the Na^+ ions. Electrolysis results.
