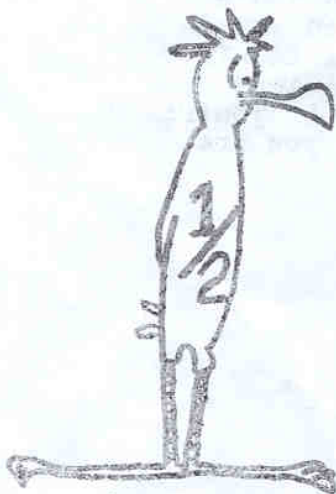


A true story of a girl who never loved and lost!
