
A cordial welcome is extended to the Class of 1975. The City of Colorado Springs is extremely proud to be the home of the United States Air Force Academy.

The Air Academy National Bank was founded in 1966 at the United States Air Force Academy to provide banking services for Cadets, Graduates, and other Air Force people on a world-wide basis. It has long been recognized that the establishment of a bank account is the first step towards financial security and the longer you are in the service the more you will realize the value of a permanent banking home. The Superintendent and his Staff are to be commended for their foresight in arranging for a full service bank at the United States Air Force Academy.

Training of Cadets in modern banking procedures is a primary mission of the Air Academy National Bank. As a part of this training Cadets are encouraged to maintain accurate checkbook records. The Academy Finance Office usually deposits Cadet pay directly to the individual account on the last working day of the month. Cadets pay a minimum reduced service charge for checking accounts; 30¢ per month, plus 5¢ per transaction. All checks and checking account supplies and professional imprinting of checks and checkbooks are furnished by the Bank without additional charge. If a minimum balance of \$300 is maintained the checking account is service free. Checking accounts established by Cadets may be retained after graduation. Graduates are eligible for a service-free checking account for the first three years of commissioned service. Hundreds of graduates world-wide have chosen to make the Air Academy National Bank their "home bank". The personal relationships which they established while here have been invaluable in providing banking services which would not otherwise be possible.
