MARRIAGE

This regulation prescribes the policy governing marriage of cadets.

1. No individual shall be admitted to the Air Force Academy in cadet status if he is, or ever was, married. No cadet is authorized to be married prior to graduation. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action leading to separation for cause. If such marriage were to occur but not be known to Air Force authorities until after graduation, individuals will be subject to disciplinary or administrative action as an officer.
2. A cadet waives any right or entitlement to certification of any academic or other credits which would otherwise accrue to him, on and after the date of any marriage by him, by affixing his signature to USAFA Form 0-611.
3. Each cadet will be required to sign an Unmarried Certificate (USAFA Form 0-205) upon accepting an appointment to the Air Force Academy. All cadets will again be required to sign an Unmarried Certificate (USAFA Form 0-611) within five (5) days after the start of Fall and Spring semesters each year.
